#### Apply for your child's school place for 2021

Applications are now open if your child is due to start school, or transferring to a middle, secondary or upper school in September 2021.

If you are applying for a place for a place to start school or to join a middle school, you have until 15th January 2021 to make an application.

The deadline for applications for young people transferring to a secondary or upper school next year is 31st October 2020.

To ensure you have the necessary information to enable you to make an informed choice regarding your child's education, Central Bedfordshire's school admission webpages also contain further information about schools in Central Bedfordshire and about the application process.

We would encourage you to apply for a school place using Central Bedfordshire's online application system. It's a quick and simple process that allows applications to be reviewed or amended at any time up until the deadline date.

#### **Forest School**

Forest School will start next week for the following classes up until 19/10/20. Classes will alternate each half term. These sessions normally alternate between the school field and Chicksands Woods, however for this half term, we will be staying on site. We will update you if there are any changes to this in the future.

Children will need to come in to school on their allocated Forest School day in old trousers (e.g.tracksuit bottoms, leggings) and old trainers/ walking boots/wellies. They will also need coats, hats and gloves as the weather gets colder. Children will be able to stay in these clothes for the rest of the day, but will need to bring in a change of shoes in a named bag.

#### **Dinner Money**

Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are entitled to free school meals so are not required to pay.

All staff are required to follow our policies and procedures working in line with the ethical framework and values of the school.


