Dear Families and Friends,

Thank you for your support with consultation evenings. We felt very supported in our measures for Covid safety and hope that this has ensured most people can make it through half term without the need to isolate. With rising numbers, we are aware that this was becoming and increasing concern.

We have been reviewing some of the activities we had planned for next half term. It had been our hope to return to normality, but measures for safety and to maintain our school environment will be in place. We will be returning to virtual assemblies for Monday celebration in school, and we will be considering whether we can invite families in for Christmas shows. Due to the rehearsals and preparation needed, we will have to make this decision as soon as we return from half term, so this is beginning to look less likely. Final decisions early in November. We will be putting on shows, and want the children to experience live performing. We have taken an early decision therefore, that we will not resort to class virtual shows. Our end of term carol performance will be outside, and we will therefore be planning this as normal, with refreshments from the PSA for you to enjoy whilst you are here.

A reminder if your child was born between 1st September 2017 to 31st August 2018, you will be thinking about applying for a school place. A nursery place in our Cherry Class does not automatically provide Central Bedfordshire Admissions with your school place for Shefford Lower School. Please do ensure you enrol with them online so that you are not disappointed.

We have a few things happening next half term, starting with the Curriculum evening. This is your opportunity to find out how we approach subjects through the curriculum such as Maths, Phonics, E-Safety and much more. Our pupil leaders are invited to share their roles too. We celebrate Diwali, and also learn about Bonfire Night before we move into Children In Need, which is a charity we will be supporting.

You might also know that we have the 100th anniversary for Armistice Day. Shefford Lower School will be represented by our Pupil Parliament to lay a wreath on the anniversary and we take part in the march on the Sunday. The town council have been encouraging family members of those named on the memorial to join them for this special anniversary.

Our Eco Council will also be joining the council to raise their 'Green Flag' at a ceremony at Bellcote Meadow Millennium Green. We will be testing out the QR trail quiz whilst we are there.



When pupils arrive late, they miss out on essential instructions given at the beginning of the lesson.

This can significantly reduce achievement, regardless of academic ability. Your child may also feel awkward arriving to the classroom when everyone else is settled. Furthermore, when one pupil arrives late, it disrupts the entire class and the teacher—everyone's education is compromised.

5 minutes late a day = 3 DAYS OF SCHOOL LOST A YEAR

10 minutes late a day = 6.5 DAYS OF SCHOOL LOST A YEAR

15 minutes late a day = 10 DAYS OF SCHOOL LOST A YEAR

20 minutes late a day = 13 DAYS OF SCHOOL LOST A YEAR

30 minutes late a day = 19 DAYS OF SCHOOL LOST A YEAR

#### Mythbusters

Myth: "It doesn't matter if my child is 5 minutes late."

**Buster:** There is a legal duty for parents to ensure children are at school each day, on time. Learning begins immediately and frequent lateness can account for several days of learning lost over a school year. Late children distract from the learning of others who arrive at school on time. Schools have a legal duty to record lateness and absence. At Shefford Lower School this is recorded on \*CPOMS.
