Curriculum Overview Year 2 Autumn Term 1

Reminders and Events

Welcome to Year 2! We are so excited for the year ahead and already have some amazing things planned for our first term. We have already been so impressed with how the children have begun their Year 2 journey. This term we will be using the United Kingdom as a focus for our learning.

Termly Texts



English In English, we will be reading a range of texts to immerse the children in our learning around the United Kingdom. We will explore a range of fiction texts to build sentences and use adjectives to expand nouns. We will also be looking at how to form sentences and the different word classes within sentences.

Maths In Maths, we will be focusing on place value and working on recognising the place value of each digit in two digit numbers (tens and ones). The children will compare and order numbers and use addition and subtraction whilst using their place value knowledge to problem solve.

Science In Science, we will be investigating 'Living Things and their Habitats' to explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead or never alive. We will be looking at different animals and how they live and adapt to their environments to survive.

Geography In Geography, we will be learning about the UK. We will look at the countries within the UK and compare landmarks and features. We will look at the different capital cities as well as locating and naming different areas of the UK.

Religious Education/PSHE

In RE we will be exploring different celebrations and festivals within Jewish faith and looking at Jewish beliefs.

In PSHE, we will learn about the importance of being a good friend and the values of friendship.

Art In Art, the children will be exploring colour. We will investigate how to make and use colours and shades in different ways for a range of effects in our own pieces as well as famous pieces of artwork.

Music In Music, we will be looking at different classical and musical composers. We will be appraising different music and composers and using the Glockenspiels to create our own pieces of music.

Computing

In Computing, we will be focusing on E-safety and looking at the importance of staying safe online.
