Termly Texts



English

In English, we will be following our Roman Britain theme through our choices of English texts. We will be writing different types of persuasive texts and descriptive writing and focusing on improving our vocabulary and descriptive language.

Maths In Maths, we will be reviewing and developing our knowledge of place value and understanding the value of each digit with numbers within the thousands. We will problem solve and look at addition and subtraction using different representations.

Science

In Science, we will be learning about 'Habitats', discovering where animals live with a focus on food webs and what they need to survive. This will also link to our Forest School sessions.

History/Geography

Our focus for this half-term is on Ancient Romans in Britain. We will look at what they did in the past as well as what they left behind for us within the UK now.
