## JOB DESCRIPTION

**Post:** Music Teacher

**Responsible to:** Headteacher

### **Purpose of the job:**

Responsibility for the education and well being of pupils as part of the staff of the school, carrying out professional duties in accordance with and subject to the conditions of employment of teachers as set out in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document. To teach pupils across the full age and ability range in music meeting the standards set in the curriculum for each year group.

- Sharing and promoting the school ethos within the context of a whole school team, supporting liaison and a collegial relationship amongst the staff of the school.
- To ensure that the individual progress, needs and general well-being of all children in your care is sensitively managed.
- To have regard for individual pupils and make excellent provision for their academic, creative, physical, social and emotional needs.
- Have high expectations of standards of work, achievement and the behaviour of all children.
- To set challenging targets for children's achievement, monitor their progress and make appropriate provision to ensure their success.
- Implement the school's agreed policies and guidelines.
- To actively promote the school's values and ethos..
- Make provision for a broad and balanced curriculum in accordance with the school's schemes of work and National Curriculum requirements.
- Ensure all lessons are thoroughly planned, prepared and appropriately differentiated in accordance with the school's agreed practice.
- Create and maintain a stimulating, tidy and organised learning environment.
- Work in partnership with learning support staff, implementing effective communication systems re. objectives and evaluations of sessions taught.
- Liaise with appropriate members of staff and representatives of external agencies to meet the individual needs of pupils.
- To actively participate in music assemblies and end of term celebration term assemblies.
- Work in partnership with parents/ carers.
- At all times have regard for health and safety of pupils and colleagues.
- Have responsibility for the co-ordination of the music curriculum, providing advice and guidance to colleagues and the subject leader for Music.
- To organise and run extra curricular activities to enable pupils to participate in a wide range of musical opportunities.
- Support the Headteacher in the furtherance of the school's aims.
