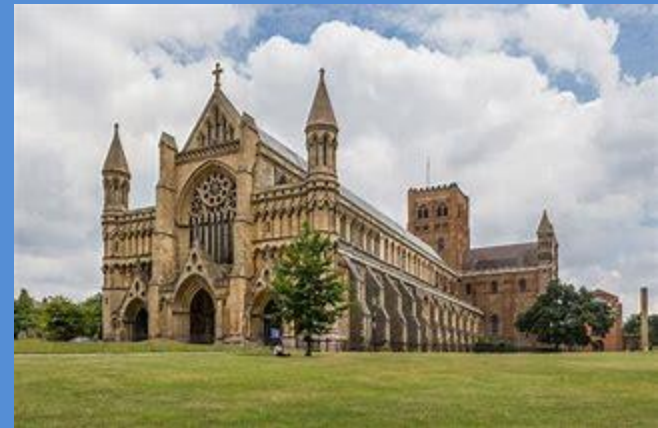

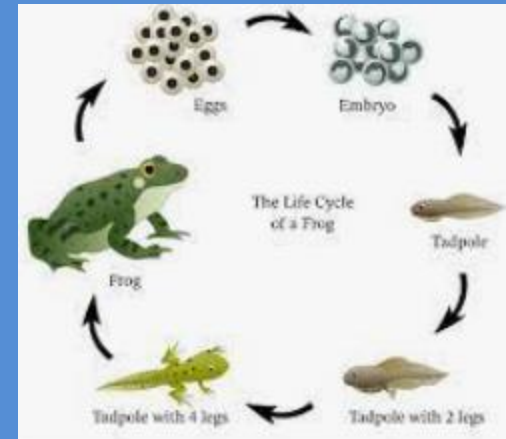


# Welcome to Year 2

In Year 2 we use Monster Phonics to support with our phonics and spellings.

The children who didn't pass their Phonics Screening Check in year 1 will retake it in the summer term. Daily phonics sessions will continue for these children.





**Spellings:** Spellings will be given weekly. These will come out on a Monday and the children will be expected to practice at home and will be assessed on a Friday. Spelling booklets will be returned on a Friday. Assessments will be in our new Home School book so you can see the scores.

**Numbots:**

Children will receive a Numbots login, that will allow them to practice their number bonds both at home and in school.

**Learning Logs:** Children in Year 2 will receive their Learning Logs once a half-term. There will be a grid in the book to choose different activities to complete. Learning Logs also include a rocket challenge if you would like to extend your child's learning further. Please feel free to present homework in additional ways e.g models, art work. Have fun and be Creative! These will be returned the last week of each half-term.

**Reading:** We expect the children to read to an adult at home **every night**, as part of their weekly homework. Children who read each night will receive a House Point the following day. Please do fill in their reading diary part of the home school book every time your child reads at home.



## Forest School

The children will take part in Forest School learning over two terms. Forest school will run during the following terms;



**Maple – Wednesday – Spring 1 and Summer 2**

**Oak – Monday – Spring 1 and Summer 2**

**Willow – Tuesday – Spring 1 and Summer 2**

Forest school is led by Mr Tilbury. The children will spend time once a week in the school forest area or Chicksands Woods. The children can come to school in their Forest School clothes and bring their uniform with them to change into afterwards. Please make sure that the children wear warm clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or wet. We will endeavour to go in most weather so please make sure that they have appropriate footwear and clothing. Forest School will only ever be cancelled in extremely high winds or storms.
